DOÑA ANA COUNTY CLERK'S APPOINTMENT OF
ELECTION BOARD MEMBERS

The Doña Ana County Clerk's Office Bureau of Elections will be appointing board members for each Voting Convenience Center for the 2022 Primary Election to be held on Tuesday, June 7, 2022. There are forty-two (42) election day Voting Convenience Center Election Boards, nine (9) Early Voting Election Boards and one (1) Absentee Election Board. To serve as an election board member you must either be registered to vote, or be 16 or 17 years of age and have your parents' or guardian's permission. At the minimum, attendance of at least one training session is required. The rate of pay ranges from \$175 to \$200 per day depending on job duties.
