



New Mexico State Canvassing Board

Order for Automatic Recount

2022 General Election

WHEREAS, NMSA 1978, Section 1-14-24(A)(3) provides that an automatic recount of the vote is required when the canvass of returns for a general election in certain offices indicates that the margin between the two candidates receiving the greatest number of votes for the office is less than one percent of the total votes cast for that office in that election; and

WHEREAS, NMSA 1978, Section 1-14-24(A) include the office of state representative; and

WHEREAS, NMSA 1978, Section 1-13-15, provides that the New Mexico State Canvassing Board is the proper canvassing board for State Representative, District 32 which includes three counties; and

WHEREAS, the canvass of returns for the November 8, 2022, General Election for State Representative, District 32, between Jenifer Marie Jones and Candie G Sweetser, resulted in a margin of 0.57 percent, which is less than one percent of the total votes cast for that office in Doña Ana County, Hidalgo County and Luna County; and

WHEREAS, NMSA 1978, Section 1-14-24(B), provides that the secretary of state shall file notice with the New Mexico State Canvassing Board within seven days after receiving notice from the county clerk following the completion of the county canvass that an automatic recount is required; and

WHEREAS, the canvass of returns for the November 8, 2022 General Election, for State Representative, District 68, between Robert Henry Moss and Charlotte L Little, resulted in a margin of 0.58 percent, which is less than one percent of the total votes cast for that office in Bernalillo County, and therefore an automatic recount is required in that contest; and

WHEREAS, on Tuesday, November 29, 2022, the Secretary of State, pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 1-14-24(B), properly notified the New Mexico State Canvassing Board that, based upon the results of the November 8, 2022 General Election, an automatic recount is required for State Representative, District 32 and State Representative, District 68;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- A. Pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 1-14-24, an automatic recount shall be conducted for State Representative, District 32 and State Representative 68;

B. The recount for State Representative, District 32, shall commence at 9:00 a.m. on Monday, December 5, 2022, in the affected counties as outlined herein:


- Doña Ana County Precincts 003, and 060; and
- Hidalgo County Precincts 001, 002, 003, 005, and 006; and
- Luna County Precincts 001, 002, 003, 004, 005, 006, 007, 008, 009, 010, 011, 012, 013, 014, 015, 016, 017, and 018; and


C. The recount for State Representative, District 68 for Bernalillo County, shall commence at 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, December 8, 2022, in the affected county as outlined herein:


- Bernalillo County Precincts 001, 019, 068, 080, 085, 087, 117, 127, 128, 129, 170, 175, 176, 177, 201, 217, 229, 230, 231, 261, 264, 606, 623, 625, 628, 631, 635, 636, 637, 641, 643, and 644; and

D. The New Mexico Secretary of State shall prescribe the conduct and procedures of the recount pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 1-14-24(C).
