

RESOLUTION NO. 2023- 49

Amended Resolution Designating Voting Convenience Centers for the 2023 Regular Local Election

WHEREAS, this amended resolution makes four changes to the DAC Resolution #2021-64: Anthony City Hall VCC location to be changed from Anthony City Hall to Anthony Public Library, Dolores Wright Educational Center VCC Location to be changed from Dolores Wright Educational Center to DACC Chaparral Branch, Mesquite Elementary School VCC location to be changed from Mesquite Elementary School to Mesquite Fire Department #10, and Sonoma Elementary School VCC location to be changed from Sonoma Elementary School to DACC Branch East Mesa; and

WHEREAS, the New Mexico Statutes Annotated 1978, §1-3-2 (2021) requires that in June or July of the odd-numbered year, the Board of County Commissioners shall by resolution designate polling places; *and*

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that each polling place designated in this resolution complies with the provisions of NMSA 1978, §1-3-7 (2021), as modified by §1-1-12(B) (2021); *and*

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that those precincts that are consolidated to create Voting Convenience Centers meet the requirements of NMSA 1978, §1-3-4 (2021) will be available to voters of any precinct in the county to cast a vote at the Voting Convenience Center, will make voting more convenient and accessible to voters of the consolidated precinct, will not result in delays for voters in the voting process and are centrally located within the consolidated precinct; *and*

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that that each polling place provides individuals with physical mobility limitations unobstructed access to at least one voting machine; *and*


WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that Voting Convenience Centers should be implemented for the 2023 Regular Local Election;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners designates the Voting Convenience Center polling locations for the 2023 Regular Local Election as follows:






