DOÑA ANA COUNTY CLERK’S APPOINTMENT OF
ELECTION BOARD OFFICIALS

The Doña Ana County Clerk’s Office Bureau of Elections will be appointing election board members for each Voting Convenience Center for the 2024 Primary Election to be held on Tuesday, June 4, 2024. There are forty-two (42) Election Day Voting Convenience Center boards, nine (9) early voting boards and one (1) absentee board. To serve as an election board member you must either be registered to vote or be 16 or 17 years of age and have your parents’ or guardian’s permission. At the minimum, attendance of at least one training session is required. The rate of pay ranges from \$300 to \$400 per day depending on job duties.
