Posting: Early Voting Information for the 2024 General Election

Pursuant to NMSA §1-6-5.6 and §1-6-5.7, the Doña Ana County Clerk’s Office is officially posting the schedule for in person Early Voting for the 2024 General Election.

Early Voting (In-person Absentee Voting) at the Doña Ana County Government Center (845 N. Motel Blvd Las Cruces NM, 88007):

Early Voting at the Doña Ana County Government will begin on October 8, 2024, from 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, until Friday, November 1, 2024.

The Doña Ana County Government Center will be open for voting on Saturday, November 2, 2024, from 10:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.

Same Day Registration will be available at the Doña Ana County Government Center while Early Voting is open. Qualified electors may register to vote or update their existing registration information before they vote.

Early Voting at the Alternate Early Voting Locations:

Alternate Site Early Voting will begin at 11:00 a.m. on Saturday, October 19, 2024, and will be open Tuesday through Saturday from 11:00 a.m. -7:00 p.m. until November 2, 2024.

Pursuant to NMSA §1-4-5.7, Same Day Registration will be available at all Alternate Early Voting locations while Early Voting is open. Qualified electors may register to vote or update their existing registration information before they vote. Voter whose political party affiliation on the voter's certificate of registration is with a major political party shall not be allowed to change party affiliation when updating an existing certificate of registration or registering to vote at a voting location immediately before voting in a primary election.

*****Absentee ballots may be returned by voters, or immediate family member, which includes a voter's spouse, child, parent, domestic partner, grandchild, grandparent, sibling or person with whom the voter has a continuing personal relationship, to any early voting site or at the Doña Ana County Clerk's Office.**
